127 students from 5 schools travelled to Morocco in October and November 2024 on a 5-day, 4-night immersive programme. Accompanied by 18 teachers, the trip combined cultural immersion, physical challenge, and practical learning.

Itinerary

Day 1	Depart UK. Arrive Marrakech. Afternoon exploring the medina and historic city centre.
Day 2	Journey to Imlil in the foothills of the Atlas Mountains. Acclimatisation walk and local familiarisation.
Day 3	Full-day trek in the Atlas Mountains. Guided by qualified local experts. Most physically demanding day of the programme.
Day 4	Adventure day in the Agafay Desert. Camel riding, traditional Moroccan cooking workshop, music and entertainment evening at desert camp.
Day 5	Cultural recovery afternoon. Visit to a local school. Evening flight back to the UK.

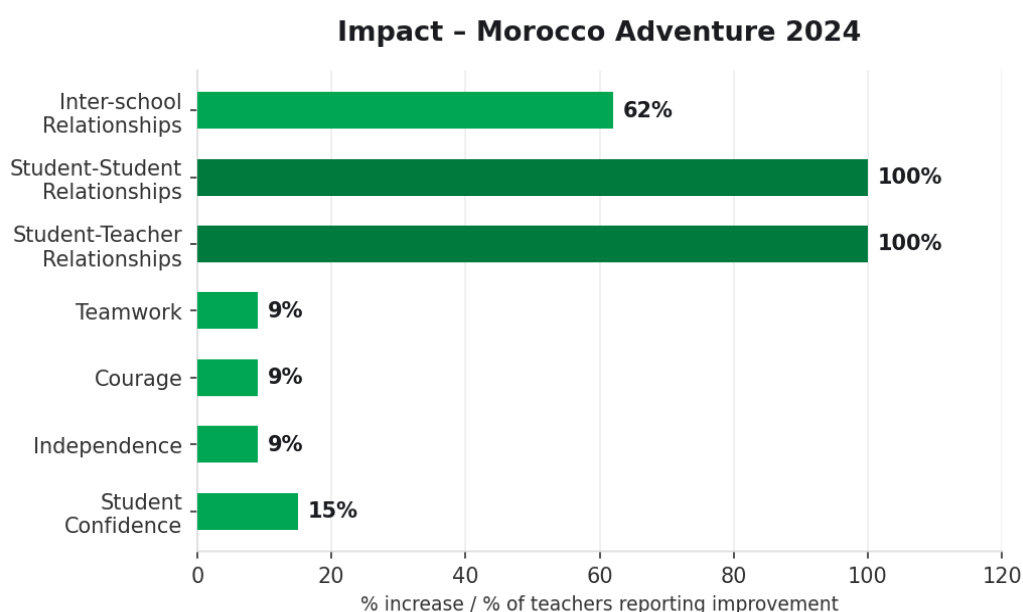
