A multi-school trust wanted to deliver a shared adventure and enrichment day programme across their schools, combining bushcraft, sport, and performing arts. The objective was high-quality, hands-on activity for 900 students without inflating costs or placing pressure on school staff.

The Challenge

Situation

A multi-school trust needed a shared adventure programme that could serve 900 students across bushcraft, sport, and performing arts – without inflating per-head costs or creating additional workload for school staff.

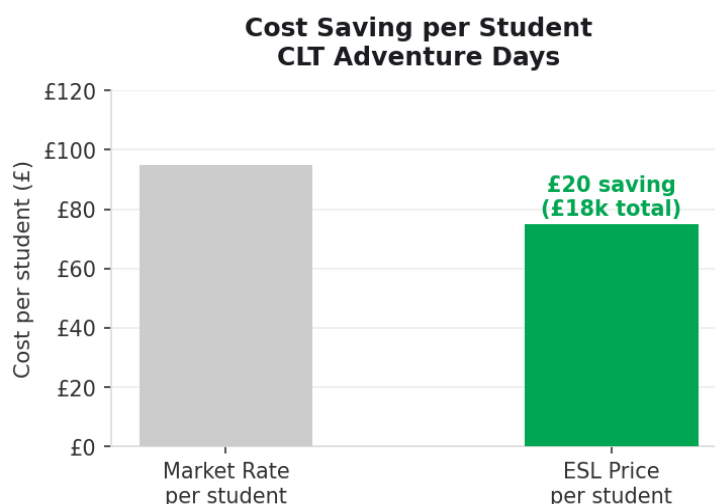
Task

Design and deliver a varied, skills-based programme across multiple activity streams with clear educational outcomes including problem solving, teamwork, and student wellbeing.

The ESL Approach

- ESL sourced and coordinated all specialist providers and delivery partners
- Programme structured across bushcraft, sports, and performing arts streams
- Full end-to-end management including venue, logistics, and on-the-day delivery
- ESL leveraged exclusive provider partnerships to negotiate below-market rates

Results



- 900 students engaged across the programme
- £20 saved per student vs standard market rate
- £18,000 total saving across the programme
- Strong educational outcomes across problem solving, teamwork, and wellbeing
- Zero planning burden placed on school staff
